

Winter Playground Rules

- a) Snow stays on the ground unless in designated areas (ie. Snowball Target Area)
- b) If you build something, you have to be okay with it getting broken
- c) You can't break it unless you built it (if group built it, must be a consensus)
- d) No climbing snow hill but snow at the bottom can be played with
- e) Snow used from the hill must be shovelled back (special shovels not used for play - stored in the entrance way on Alverstone)
- f) No water bottles/ice making outside
- g) No standing on ice patches but you can sit and crawl on them (must have ski pants and mitts/gloves)
- h) Sleds can be used for designated grades at recess time only in the roped off area
 - i) No standing on sleds
 - ii) Only 1 person pulling at a time
 - iii) Take turns/share
 - iv) Must have ski pants and mitts/gloves
 - v) Play safe (ie. no crashing into each other, no whipping around)
- i) If you play basketball, you must have mitts/gloves on
- j) While waiting in line to come into the school, brush off snow
